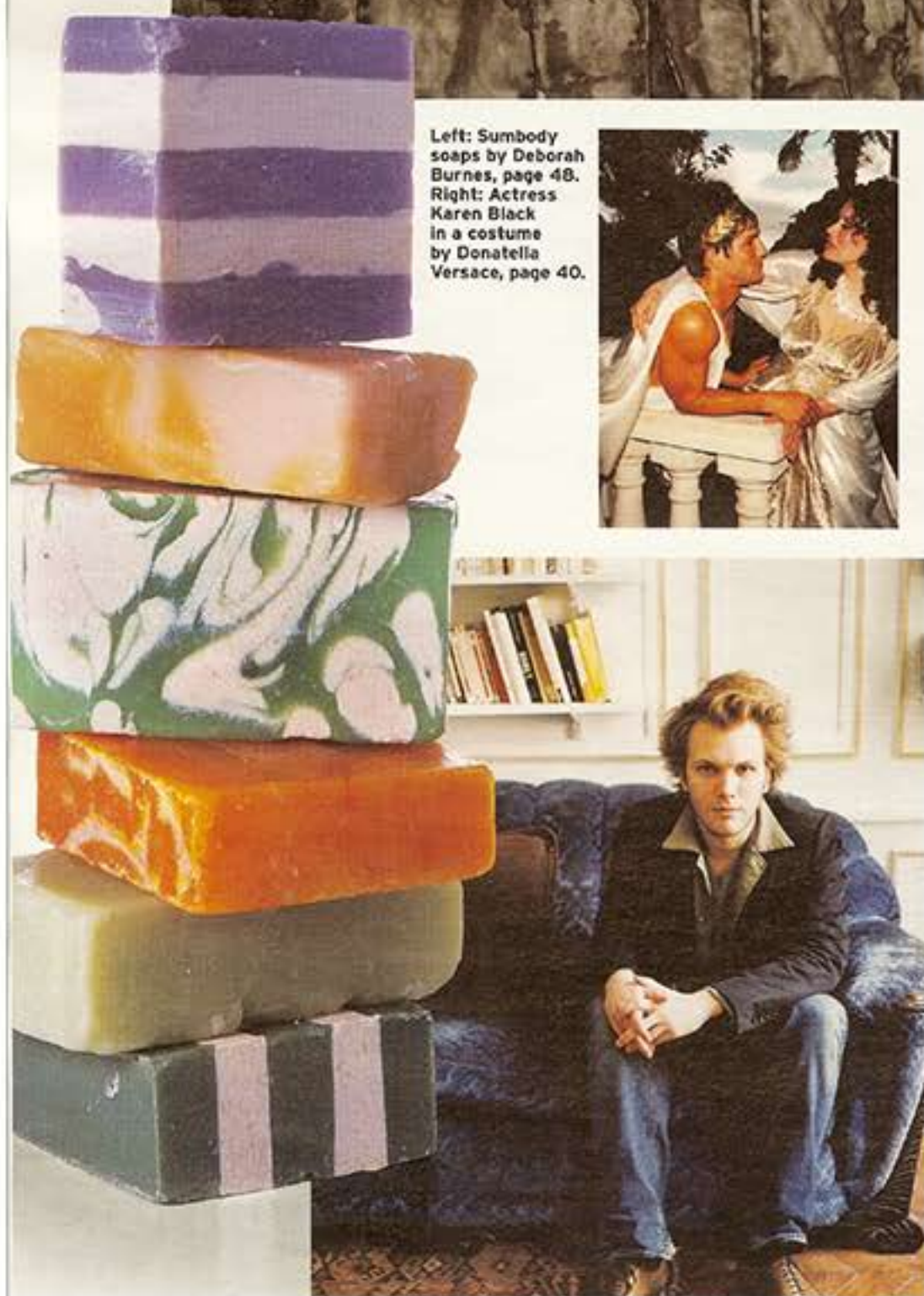


Jasper Johns's *From Henri Matisse*, 2000. The painter discusses his life, his art and his legacy on page 64.

With Sumbody soaps, Deborah Burnes is challenging the long-standing belief that massive cascades of bubbles are the key to clean skin.
